### SPECIAL SCHOOL

We have a very comprehensive special school. Main features of our school are:

- All types of necessary services as per individual need of the student.
- 2. Maintained by well trained registered professionals.
- Standardized checklist for assessment and programming.
- 4. Individualized learning.
- 5. Classes with adequate space for class teaching and activity.
- 6. Resource Room.
- 7. Smart class room with large smart TV and audio system.
- 8. Attractive Environment Building as Learning Aid.
- 9. Extensive use of innovative teaching aids.
- 10. Multi sensory Intervention Therapy.
- 11. Early Intervention & Play Therapy
- 12. Yoga, Music & Dance Therapy.
- 13. Behaviour Modification Service.
- 14. Speech & Physiotherapy.
- 15. Computer basics.
- 16. Prevocational training.
- 17. Additional services like Guidance to parents, Interclass competitions, Awareness and Identification programmes, Workshops etc.

The students' strength of our school is 100 at Special School and 21 at VTC as on 01.04.22.

Last year we admitted 22 Students and 9 of our existing students successfully completed our special

school, 8 students transferred for admission in normal school for inclusion and dropped out number is 9.

Our teachers participated in several workshops / seminars at state and national level to update and broaden their knowledge. We lost 2 of our students in this year due to severe physical illness.

### **VOCATIONAL TRAINING CENTRE**

This unit also gets appreciation from all over the country. Here we provide training for making various types of innovative products maintaining the quality and demand of the market. Some students are also getting





monthly remuneration for their production. Presently we have -

- a. Tailoring Here several types of bags and school bags are made along with school uniform and several other types of cloths. Also folders and related items are made.
- b. Silk Screen Printing Here we make cards, pads, folders and related items successfully.
- c. Stitching and Pico Several types of hand embroidery and pico of sarees are done.
- d. Handicrafts Based on the market survey (Which is very essential to find out the demands of the consumer) folders, mats, decorative pieces, curtains, Key rings are made here.

The sales outlet of this section is named as "Srijoni", the aim of this unit is to provide economic independence after vocational training to the students with Intellectual Disabilities.

### C. RESIDENTIAL CARE UNIT FOR BOYS

Our residential care unit for boys earns the reputation as a pioneering residential care unit for its' scientific planning and good caring service. The environment is also very pleasant and calm as it is located on the bank of river Ganges. A planned routine for daily activities and a balanced food chart are followed in this unit. A medical officer and a psychiatrist regularly check our students.
